CHAMPAGNE

Lanson Brut Rose NV

\$130

Blend : 32% Chardonnay, 53% Pinot Noir, 15% Pinot Meunier

From one of the most respected Champagne houses, this is a delicate rose with salmon pink hues and fine bubbles. Floral notes and soft red berry characters linger on the palate with a creamy texture imparted by 3 years ageing on yeast lees.

WHITE WINE

Domaine Zind Humbrecht, Riesling 2001

One of the leading lights in biodynamic viticulture, Zind Humbrecht

Are renowned for being one of the greatest domains in Alsace. This Riesling is typically rich in style with superb acidity to keep the wine in balance. The intense nose displays aromas of honey coated tropical fruits and just a hint of spice, light balanced petrol notes in this aged Riesling.

Domaine Ramonet, Chassagne Montrachet 2004

Domaine Ramonet are the undisputed masters of Chassagne Montrachet, a small appellation in the Cote d'Or sub region of Burgundy. This wine has a lovely golden colour and shows notes of vanilla and hints of spice on a taut mineral backbone. A typically Burgundian style of Chardonnay.

Weingut Hiedler, Gruener Veltliner „Spiegel“ 2006

\$69

Gruener Veltliner is a very popular grape variety these days and has really put Austria back on the wine map. The nose of this spicy wine is unobtrusive but nevertheless focused and leads on to a palate with a hint of rhubarb followed by a delicate mineral finish.

An Argentinian Bordeaux-style wine, Blend: 40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Malbec, 20% Merlot. A great New World version of a traditional style. A complex nose of redcurrant, mocha and tobacco leads on to a supple palate with a smooth finish.

Roda I Reserva, 2001

\$160

Roda has 17 vineyards in Rioja, some each of the three regions. The produce of each vineyard is vinified separately in 17 oak fermenter, then put into french oak barrels.

It is built for aging. Deep, dark red in colour. The nose starts off very closed with subtle dark fruit and earth, but builds into a great wiff of blackberry and black current with liquorice, spice, florals and earthy undergrowth. The mouth feel is pure velvet with classic Roda tannins.

Chateau Sociando-Mallet, St. Seurin-de-Cadourne, 1995

\$170

"This accessible, yet tannic example of Sociando-Mallet possesses a deep ruby/purple colour, and excellent aromatics consisting of jammy black cherries, blackberries, and cassis, as well as subtle notes of minerals, earth, and new oak. This is a deep, long, muscular, tannic wine that is structurally similar to the 1996.
